

## Title 38 United States Code Section 3679(e) School Compliance Form

As part of the Veterans Benefits and Transition Act of 2018, section 3679 of title 38, United States Code was amended, and educational institutions are required to sign this compliance form to confirm your compliance with the requirements as outlined.

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
